Reason why Restricted: <u>Product is on Marin IPM Landscape Use Allowed</u> <u>Products Exemption List, per the County IPM ordinance application of pesticides to turf is restricted. However this product is a reduced-risk pesticide with no signal word, so relative safety to both the handler and environment.</u>	
Reason for Need: Given the complex conditions surrounding the management of turf at the golf course, including mowing heights less than 1/8", comgined with the winter moisture and fluctuating temperatures, the turf is highly susceptible to a variety of diseases and fungi. Golf course greens are currently being destroyed by cutworms that must be treated, otherwise the greens will experience significant damage making the course unusable.	
Options/Alternatives: Chitin-inhibiting bait stations may be used as alternative; however, bait stations are not listed on Allowable Pesticide List and similar exemption is required.	
Plan to Preclude Future Use: <u>Continue to implement best management practices</u> such as aeration, fertilization, overseeding and top dressing to improve the health of greens and tee boxes.	
Time Period Needed: Six months, 5/8/18 through 11/8/18
