

Protecting Tiburon Communities and Rare Plants

Marin County Open Space District, Marin County Fire, and Tiburon Fire are in partnership to implement a fire fuel reduction project that will help reduce fire risk to neighbors bordering Old Saint Hilary's open space preserve while also protecting rare plant habitat inside the preserve.

In July 2020, Marin County Fire cut mature stands of Acacia growing along the southern boundary of the preserve,

chipping the material on site. As a follow up to this work, Marin County Parks staff will return to remove any remaining Acacia trees in the vicinity. The stumps will be carefully painted with a triclopyr based herbicide to prevent regrowth.
