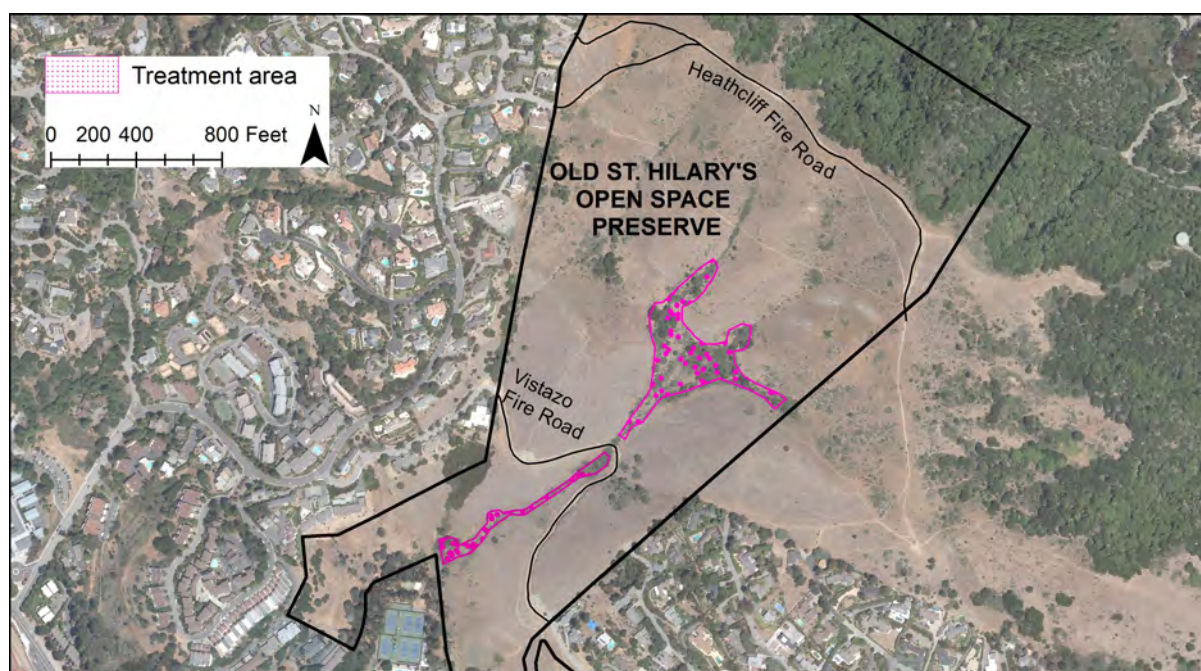

PROTECTING BIODIVERSITY

PREVENTING INVASIVE WEEDS

October 9 - 12, 2023



Acacia, pyracantha, cotoneaster, cherry plum, and Himalayan blackberry are fast-growing invasive plants, which can spread quickly if left unmanaged. Staff carefully places a small amount of herbicide, by hand, onto the trunk or stem of a plant.

Stopping the spread of these invasive species helps to protect rare species and reduces fire risk.
